Mika Nieminen holds Doc. Soc. Sc. from the University of Tampere. His key areas of expertise are science, technology and innovation policy and higher education policy. Before moving to his current position in 2008, he worked as a senior researcher in the VTT group of Innovation Policy Research and Impact Assessment of R&D. He has studied e.g. changes in S&T policy and its resources and cooperation between universities and companies in several research projects. In addition, he has evaluated science and technology programmes, acted as a special investigator for the Ministry of Education and been a coordinator for a post-graduate school in S&T studies. During his career he has also been a member of several expert bodies including e.g. Finnish Higher Education Evaluation Council and participated in various development processes like University Alliance Finland.

University Alliance Finland is a university consortium formed by the University of Jyväskylä, Tampere University of Technology and University of Tampere. The development of the alliance was started in 2007 and it was formally established in the summer 2008. The University alliance aims at developing its member universities in international forefront via strategic collaboration and division of labour. University Alliance Finland is currently Finland's most research intensive and internationally oriented university complex. It is also the biggest university consortium in Finland in terms under-graduate students.
